

STRATEGIES

English Language Arts

In order to impact ELA performance staff will:

- **1.** Instructional staff engage in professional learning on writing about reading including the implementation of "Being a Writer".
- **2.** Administrators schedule structured time for teachers to collaboratively plan. Teachers engage in purposeful collaborative planning for writing about reading supported by the RST.

Mathematics

In order to impact Math performance staff will:

- 1. Instructional staff engage in professional learning on identifying, selecting, and implementing high quality mathematics tasks. Instructional staff select, implement and score high-quality tasks to provide multiple entry points through the use of varied tools and representations.
- **2.** Administrators schedule structured time for teachers to collaboratively plan. Teachers engage in purposeful collaborative planning for selecting and implementing high-quality tasks from Canvas supported by the MST.

Discipline

In order to impact Discipline performance the staff will:

- **1.** Instructional staff have a time in their schedule to provide direct instruction on social emotional competencies.
- 2. Staff will explore implicit bias and will gain an awareness of perceived, visible, and non-visible differences in students.
- **3.** Staff will create a culture where students and staff feel welcomed and included. Strategies include positive postcards, lunch bunches, SOARING Eagle bracelets, PBIS prizes, staff meeting & greeting students everyday.
