



The staff of Veterans

The four SOAR expectations, which we promote at school, can be applied to situations both inside and outside the school building. The following are a few examples:

### SAFE:

School: Walk in the hallway Home: Walk through the house Community: Obey traffic rules

#### ORGANIZED:

School: Pack your homework to go home Home: Pack your homework in your backpack Community: Pack materials for sports events

### ACT RESPONSIBLY:

School: Keep desk area clean House: Clean your room Community: Remember to recycle

### RESPECTFUL:

School: Listen to staff and teachers Home: Clean your room Community: Hold doors and help others

# How is our program different from other school behavior programs?

- ★ Our program is focused on teaching and providing frequent feedback to students about positive behavior.
- ★ Routines and expectations related to SOAR behaviors are consistent throughout the school.
- ★ As students SOAR, the amount of time for learning increases, resulting in increased student improvement and academic success.

# Consequences for Inappropriate Behavior

Students have been taught the school expectations for classroom and non-classroom settings. If a child does not follow one of the four SOAR expectations, the following procedures will be followed:


- Verbal Warning with reminder about appropriate behavior.
- Stop, Think and Decide with reminder about appropriate behavior.
- S Time out provided/MIRS form completed.
- Student is sent to buddy teacher.
- ⑤ Phone call home is made.
- 6 Office referral is made.\*

\* Certain actions warrant immediate administrative involvement, such as fighting, using inappropriate language, possession of contraband or weapons, harassment and threats.

## EAGLE EARNINGS

- ★ Students who are following the school expectations in the various locations of the school can earn Eagle Earnings.
- ★ Eagle Earnings are given by staff to students to provide positive feedback about their expected behavior.
- ★ Students can redeem Eagle Earnings for privileges and school items on the Eagle Cart.
