FROM THE PRINCIPAL:

We administered the Measures of Academic Progress to all students in Grades 1-5 over the last few months.

In a few weeks, you will be receiving your child's scores. This test is just **ONE** measure of your child's performance in school. As with all assessment scores, it is one consideration when looking at student program and placement. In a few weeks we will also have our Parent Teacher Conferences. This is an informative time when the teacher can share your child's progress in their classroom on other measures of classroom growth. **During American Education Week, we will give parents two opportunities to learn a little more about the assessment results. On Wednesday November 19th, our school visit day, we will run a session on the test results in the Mini-Auditorium from 9:45-10:15 and again that evening at 7:00-7:30 pm. in the Media Center.** We will also send home some explanatory materials with the assessment results.

November 17-21 is American Education Week. The theme this year is once again "Great Public Schools-A Basic Right and Our Responsibility. While this week is set aside for parents to visit, the main visit day is Wednesday November 19th. Parents do not have to call this week, just sign in at the office. Again, normal visiting rules apply. We ask parents not to take photographs of any children while in the school building. We also ask that you not use your cell phone while in the building. If you must use your cell phone please use the area outside the main lobby at the front door. Parents may not bring young children with them during their visit, it is still an instructional day for our students and we want as few distractions as possible. We look forward to celebrating a great week with you. There is so many great things happening here.
